Responsibilities:

- Catch, insert, and pack products off high-speed gluer machines.
 - Inspect materials and products for defects and ensure conformance to specifications through quality checks before and during production runs.
 - Perform finishing make-ready tasks prior to machine start-ups.
 - Assist with machine make-ready and clean-up as needed.
 - Load materials and products into machines, equipment, or conveyors using hand tools and moving devices.
 - Remove materials and products from machines and equipment, placing them in boxes, trucks, or conveyors.
 - Identify and mark materials, products, and samples according to instructions.
 - Fasten, package, or stack materials and products using hand tools and fastening equipment.
 - Weigh or measure materials or products to ensure they meet specifications.
 - Record production and operational data, such as material processed.
 - Add chemicals or solutions to machines or equipment as required by the manufacturing process.
 - Transfer materials and products to and from machinery using industrial or hand trucks.
 - Follow all safety, quality, and company policies and procedures.
 - Attend and participate in ongoing training.
 - Perform other duties as assigned.
