Knowledge and Requirements:

- Minimum 1 year of experience in a printing environment.
 - High school diploma or equivalent.
 - Ability to perform routine maintenance on printing equipment.
 - Experience feeding a 6-color Heidelberg press.
 - Skilled in filling ink fountains, mounting plates, and piling full-size sheets.
 - Mechanically inclined with strong problem-solving skills.
 - Good verbal and written communication skills.
 - Ability to work independently and collaboratively within a team environment.
 - Meticulous, reliable, and trustworthy.

Responsibilities:

- Prepare all paper stock and ensure correct substrate is loaded according to print docket instructions and guidance from the Lead Pressman.
 - Set up and adjust the feeder end of the press.
 - Load paper into the press feeder and ensure continuous feeding throughout the press run.
 - Mix inks as directed by the Lead Pressman and load them into press ink fountains.
 - Off-load and re-stack finished printed products onto skids and move them to designated staging areas.
 - Perform press wash-up duties and routine press maintenance as required.
 - Remove plates upon completion of press runs.
 - Accurately follow Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) and written job instructions.
 - Support the Lead Pressman and assist with basic press maintenance and repairs.
 - Maintain close attention to detail throughout all aspects of the process.
 - Clean and maintain machinery, equipment, and work areas to ensure proper functioning and safe working conditions.
 - Perform other duties as assigned by the Lead Pressman or Manager.

Physical Demands:
